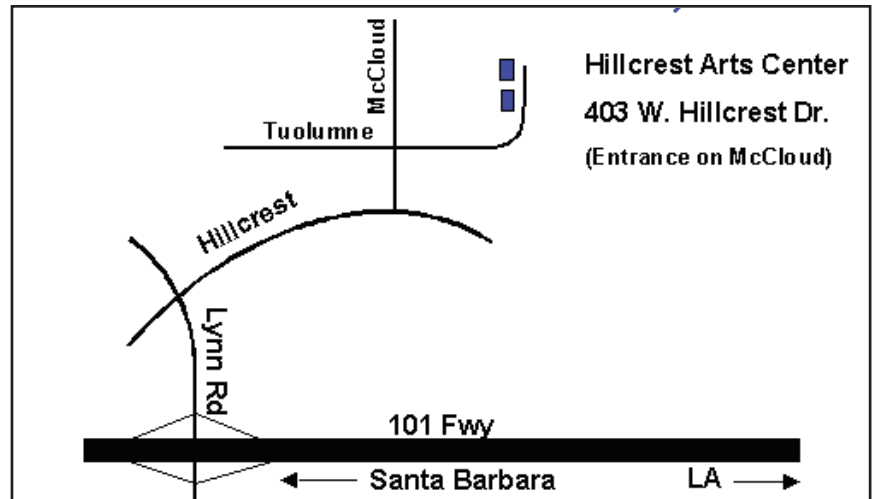

Directions:

Exit 101 at Lynn Road and turn right onto Lynn if coming from Los Angeles or left over the freeway if coming from Santa Barbara. Make a right turn almost immediately, avoiding the entrance into The Oaks shopping mall by taking the right lane that bypasses the traffic light and curves onto Hillcrest Drive. Make the first possible left (second light) onto McCloud Avenue and first right onto Civic Center Drive, a long uphill entrance to the National Parks Building and the Hillcrest Center. At the stop sign at the top of the hill turn left. The first building (#401) is the National Parks Headquar-



ters. The second building (both of them on your left), #403, is the Hillcrest Center.

Parking is at roof level. Go down the stairs or use the outdoor elevator.
